Congratulations on your new Kitten

You have just acquired a wonderful new member to your family! Your new kitten depends on you for all its needs like a new baby depends on its mother. To help you provide your kitten with the best possible preventative healthcare, Care Animal Hospital offers a complete Kitten Wellness Plan. This is complete healthcare for your kitten for an entire year. It allows them to get their best start to wellness care. The payment for this 1 year plan are divided into 12 equal payments or you also have the option to pay in full at time of enrollment. When your pet comes in for the first time and is signed up on the plan, the first month's payment will be made as well as an Enrollment Fee. After this, the automatic payment will be made on the 15th of every month. Wellness Plans can be renewed in a year for the Adult Wellness Plan after this one expires. Below is all services that are included in the plan.

This plan includes:

Kitten Physical Exams (4 exams): Done with each vaccine visit to make sure that your kitten is healthy enough for the vaccine, to offer any advice about kitten care and development, and for kitten socialization in a veterinary clinic.

Comprehensive Physical Exam (1 exam): Complete exam to be used any time that your kitten is sick or injured.

Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia (FRCP) Vaccine (4 vaccines): This three-way vaccine protects your kitten against infectious diseases. It is given every 3 weeks until 16 weeks of age.

Feline Leukemia (FELV) (2 vaccines): Given at 12 and 14 weeks of age to protect from Feline Leukemia.

Rabies Vaccine: Given at 16 weeks of age.

Feline Triple Test: A blood test checking for Feline Leukemia Virus, FIV (Feline Immunodeficiency Virus), and Feline Heartworm.

Fecal Examinations (2 exams): This stool sample test looks for intestinal parasites.

Deworming (2 doses): This medication is for intestinal parasites.

Nail Trim (5 nail trims): To be done every kitten visit for training purposes as well as used throughout the year.

Kitten Information Packet (2): Including the first month of Revolution Plus, Feliway travel spray, and important kitten information.

Revolution Plus Prevention (12 month supply): Topical, monthly prevention that is given to prevent fleas, ticks, intestinal parasites, and heartworm disease all year.

This **Kitten Wellness Plan** starts with your first visit and ends in 12 months. The monthly payment is **\$85.07** with a \$40.00 enrollment fee. Total value of the Wellness Plan is \$1,122.92. This includes a 10% discount on this plan.

Q&A--

- —Is there a discount for doing as a plan? Yes: 10%
- —Are the payments automatically charged? Yes on the 15th of every month.
- —Can I add on anything else with the payment? No. Any additional vaccines, services, products are to be paid at the time of service.
- -Can I decide on a different day to do the plan? No. After services are given, we cannot go back and put them on a plan.
- -Can I substitute items in the plan? No. We have made them to provide best medicine and more reasonable way of paying for it.
- —Are Urgent Care Exams included in the plan? No. Only Kitten Exams (4) and Wellness Exam (1) are included as per plan.
- —Are Nursing Care Exam included in the plan? No.
- —Are medications, radiographs, lab testing, spay/neuter included in the plan? No.
- —What about patients that cannot have or do not want Revolution plus? At this time we do not have plans that don't include prevention or different types of prevention.
- -What happens at year end? A renewal notice will be sent out 30 days prior to the plan expiring to set up the next plan.

Scheduling: Please make sure to fill out the <u>registration form</u> located under the "clients" section on our website as soon as possible. Registration form must be received prior to scheduling an appointment. Whenever possible, please attach records at the bottom of the registration form, or e-mail to registration@careanimalhospital.com. We understand that in many circumstances paperwork is not received until the kitten is acquired. So that our doctors can provide the best care possible, please bring all medical records with you to the first appointment if you are unable to send them ahead of time. Without medical records, we may not be able to do all planned services for the visit.
